

Advisee Responsibilities in Meeting Program Outcomes

Advisees will

- Work to clarify life goals and career/educational goals and to make personal and academic decisions that reflect these goals
- Make course selections for each semester that permit timely completion of core curriculum and degree requirements, that enable them to take full advantage of the liberal arts environment and the educational opportunities offered therein, and that allow them to “construct” themselves as individual life-long learners
- Accept responsibility for personal and academic decisions and outcomes of these decisions
- Maintain contact with the advisor by keeping required appointments, making additional appointments as necessary, preparing appropriately for appointments, and bringing necessary materials
- Express needs and concerns to the advisor in a clear and timely way
- Ask questions and listen carefully to what the advisor has to say
- Follow through on referrals and recommendations provided by the advisor
- Use the resources available to them (SmartNet, *To the Point*, faculty members, Academic Services, Career Services, student life personnel) in making informed decisions
