Post-graduate Alumni Scholarship

Conditions and Eligibility for Application and Acceptance of the Scholarship

The guidelines appearing below apply to an annual \$5,000 Scholarship award given to a St. Mary's alumni attending graduate school.

Conditions for Applying:

- The Scholarship application packet must include the following:
 1. Completion of application
 2. (3) Reference letters
 3. Undergraduate academic record (transcript) – graduate/professional school transcript when applicable
 4. Personal statement (essay) why applicant should be the recipient
 5. Resume or vitae
- The deadline for receipt of the application packet is **May 1st**, mailed to the Office of Alumni Relations, 18952 E. Fisher Road, St. Mary's College of Maryland, St. Mary's City, MD 20686-3001

Eligibility for Scholarship:

- Applicant must be a degree-holding St. Mary's College of Maryland alumni (or its predecessor schools), or a St. Mary's College of Maryland graduating senior
- Applicants must be applying to or attending a full-time, degree-seeking graduate program.
- The Scholarship award is not renewable, automatically, however, former awardees may receive more than one award by reapplying in subsequent years
- The Scholarship award is paid directly to the business office of the institution attended by the awardee. (Verification of acceptance from the awardee's graduate or professional school program must precede payment of Scholarship award.)
