London - India - Italy- and
The Classic Old West



London Theatre Tour

January 4-12, 2007

Guided by theatre professor David Groupé, you will be treated to four new stage productions in London, tour museums, a journey to Stratford-upon-Avon, and more.

Cost is \$2,190 per person. Double occupancy covers accommodations at the Strand Palace Hotel (central London), full English breakfast each morning, two dinners, tickets to plays, trip to Stratford, round-trip airfare (non-stop) between Dulles and London, and transportation from St. Mary's County to airport.

Single supplement: \$490 Deposit of \$200 no later than October 1, 2006.



A Profile of India: Pilgrims, Princes, and Peasants

March 4-24, 2007

This educational tour of almost three weeks focuses on northern India. It includes a three-day trip on the luxury train, Heritage on Wheels, through the desert to Bikaner and then through the open-air museum of northern Rajasthan. The study tour, with lectures, is led by Frank van Aalst, former professor of history at St. Mary's, who has also lived and taught in India. The tour begins in Delhi and goes directly to Varanasi (Banaras) where participants will witness a Prayer Ceremony from a boat on the ancient River Ganges. The tour includes Jaipur and its Jewelers' Bazaar; a rickshaw ride through the Bird Sanctuary at Bharat-pur; a visit to Agra to see the Taj Mahal at sunset; Udaipur of southern Rajasthan and its rural community development programs; and Bombay.

Cost: \$5,100 per person, double occupancy. It includes round-trip airfare from Dulles to India, admission to all scheduled attractions, and all meals in India except for one dinner and two lunches.

Single supplement: \$1,177

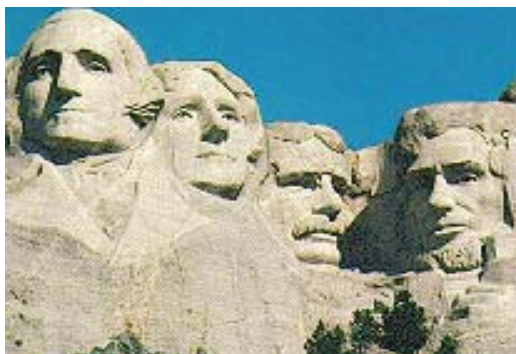
The Classic Old West
