GRE GENERAL TEST (Required for admission to grad programs in many disciplines)

The General Test is only administered as a computer-based test. It is offered many days every month at several sites throughout Maryland. Unofficial scores from the multiple choice sections are available immediately, and complete official scores are available 2 weeks later. To find a testing center and register go to www.ets.org/gre. Registration Bulletins are also available in the Career Development Center (CDC).

GRE SUBJECT TEST (Required for admission to some graduate programs)

The Subject Test measures achievement in specific subjects and is only administered as a paper-based test at arranged testing sites 3 times per year. Scores are available by phone after 1 month & by mail within 6 weeks.

PRAXIS (Required for Master of Arts in Teaching)

Praxis I Pre-Professional Skills Tests are required for entry into the SMCM MAT program. Praxis II Subject Assessments are necessary for licensing. These paper-based tests are administered 7 times per year at arranged sites throughout Maryland. The Praxis I is also available year-round as a computer-based test. Scores are available after 2-3 (computer-based) or 4 (paper-based) weeks. To find a testing center and register go to www.ets.org/praxis. Registration Bulletins are also available in the CDC.

LSAT (Required for admission to law school)

The LSAT is only administered as a paper-based test 4 times per year (dates below) at arranged testing sites throughout Maryland **(INCLUDING SMCM FOR THE OCTOBER DATE ONLY!)**.
