### Luginbill wins internship

Elizabeth Luginbill of Leonardtown is the winner of the 2005 William Donald Schaefer Internship Program for Government Service Award.

Luginbill, a junior at St. Mary's College, will do a summer internship in the office of St. Mary's County Circuit Court Judge Marvin Kaminetz.

"It is an honor to receive the Schaefer Award," Luginbill said, according to a release. She is studying abroad at the University of Alcalá in Madrid, Spain, this semester. "I am looking forward to applying the skills I have learned at St. Mary's in a work environment and exploring juvenile justice issues, especially the juvenile drug court."

The Center for the Study of Democracy, a joint project of St. Mary's College and Historic St. Mary's City, created the award to encourage students at the college to pursue future careers in public service by granting them a hands-on, undergraduate experience in public policy. The award carries a stipend of \$1,000 and assistance toward placement within an agency related to the winner's field of interest.

Luginbill is pursuing a double-major at St. Mary's in history and international languages and cultures. She is the vice president and founding member of the SMC Model United Nations Club, a member of the Celtic Club, the Student Government Association and the pre-law advisory network.

She is a 2002 honors graduate of Leonardtown High School and served as a mentor in the Spring Ridge Middle School mentor program.

She has also worked as a volunteer at the Boys and Girls Club of America and at Three Oaks, a shelter in Lexington Park.
