

FULBRIGHT FELLOWSHIPS IN BUSINESS AND ECONOMICS

For the 2004—2005 academic year, applications will be accepted from well-qualified candidates for graduate study or research in business and economics. Candidates must be U.S. citizens at the time of application and may apply to only one of the above countries.

The amounts of the fellowships will vary with the country of application, but all will provide for international travel, settling-in, maintenance, tuition waivers (where applicable), and health and accident insurance.

Specific eligibility requirements and information on benefits are contained in the brochure, *Fulbright and Related Grants for Graduate Study and Research Abroad, 2004—2005*, which may be obtained from campus Fulbright Program Advisers (for enrolled students) or from any of IIE's offices (listed below — for students not enrolled in a college or university at the time of application). Information may also be accessed on IIE's Web site at [Mp://www.iie.org/fulbright/us/](http://www.iie.org/fulbright/us/). October 21, 2003 is the application deadline.

Germany Five Fulbright Enterprise Awards will be available in the fields of law, business, and international relations for candidates interested in close cooperation with the private sector, in addition to university-based research and study.

India One Fulbright grant on topics relevant to Indian economy and society will be partially supported by the National Council for Applied Economic Research (NCAER), New Delhi.

Japan The Fulbright Commission welcomes applications from students currently enrolled in graduate business programs. While these grants are primarily for research, they may be used partly for supplementary Japanese language study, or for an internship to supplement the research.

Mexico The Fulbright Commission will offer up to eight grants in binational business to candidates at all degree levels. Fellows will follow a course of study at a Mexican university and will be assigned an internship at a company in Mexico.

Spain Two international MBA Grants for full-time study in a one-year international MBA program at the Instituto de Empresa in Madrid, as well as a period of elective seminars and a three-month assessed internship will be available.

United Kingdom Fulbright MBA Grants are available to U.S. citizens who wish to fund their first year of a Master's in Business Administration at an education institution within the United Kingdom.

Uruguay The Fulbright Commission in Uruguay will offer up to five grants in the fields of business administration, communications, international trade and economics to graduate students interested in an international career. Fellows will take courses at a Uruguayan university and will be assigned an internship at a company in Uruguay.
