## The History

Omicron Delta Epsilon, one of the largest international academic honor societies, was established in 1963 as a result of a merger of two honor societies: Omicron Delta Gamma (founded in 1915 by Professor John R. Commons at the University of Wisconsin and Frank W. Taussig at Harvard University); and Omicron Chi Epsilon (founded in 1956 by Professor Alan A. Brown when he was a student at the City College of New York). Currently, Omicron Delta Epsilon has 578 chapters across the world.
