Commons at the University of Wisconsin and Frank W. Taussig at Harvard University); and Omicron Chi Epsilon (founded in 1956 by Professor Alan A. Brown when he was a student at the City College of New York). Currently, Omicron Delta Epsilon has 578 chapters across the world.
