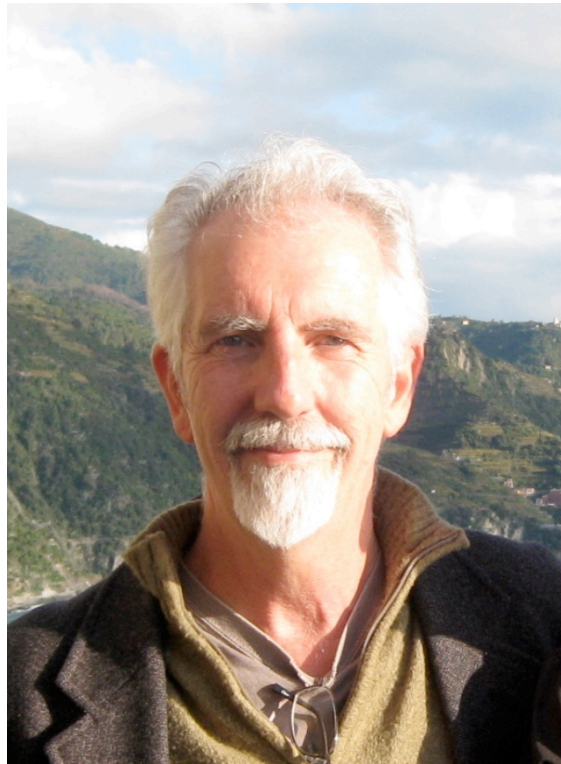


The Mark Twain Lecture Series on American Humor and Culture presents:
