St. Mary's College of Maryland Alumni Weekend Waterfront Boat Docking Policy

- 1. The College will extend dockage to alumni and will honor the reservations of those who have registered to the extent that space is available.
- 2. Alumni are always welcome to anchor out and "dinghy in" to the beach.
- 3. Alumni must register their boat by submitting the information requested below. Once approved, the waterfront staff will send a confirmation via email with additional information, including a dockage map.
- 4. Overnight dockage shall be permitted on Friday and Saturday nights. (Boats may remain on the pier after sunset.)
- 5. Visitors will dock on the exterior of the pier, unless instructed to use an open slip by the waterfront staff. Those in open slips may not move their boat between the hours of 12 pm and 6 pm on Friday and Saturday when the waterfront is roped off for swimming and recreation.
- 6. Boats may not block the space needed for the commercial river tour boat going out on Saturday afternoon and evening. This boat is often enjoyed by those with limited mobility so pier access to the tour boat can't be blocked in any way.
- 7. Boat owners are guests of the College and shall be responsible for their behavior and the behavior of their guests.
- 8. Please help foster a safe and pleasant experience for all. Call Public Safety at (240) 895-4911 if you witness any unsafe behavior at the waterfront.

<u>Special Note:</u> SMCM only has 110v power outlets and may not be able to support more than one boat without tripping the circuit breaker. If the circuit is tripped, only the waterfront professional staff can reset the power since the panel is in a locked room.
