APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE TUITION EXCHANGE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM AT ST. MARY'S COLLEGE OF MARYLAND

The Tuition Exchange (TE) program provides scholarships for eligible dependent children of St. Mary's employees. TE is a partnership of over 600 colleges and universities offering tuition exchange scholarships to employees at member institutions. Participation in the program is limited by a number of factors as outlined in the "Policies on the Tuition Exchange Scholarship Program." For example, enrollment is limited and tied to the number of students who wish to enroll at St. Mary's. Employees interested in the program may obtain a copy of the policies from the Office of Human Resources and should refer to it before making application. Application to the program does not guarantee acceptance at the TE member institution, nor does acceptance at the host institution insure a TE scholarship.

To apply to the TE program as an employee of St. Mary's College, complete this application and return it to the Office of Human Resources. The deadline to be considered for participation for the Fall 2010 term is November 1, 2009. Applications not complete by this date will be considered only on a space available basis. Applications are only considered one time each year.
