The staff of the student health and counseling center extends a special welcome to you as you prepare to begin your studies at St. Mary's College of Maryland.

Please complete and return the attached health history and immunization form at your earliest convenience. Completion of the form is mandatory for all full-time students. A physical examination is not required, however; *the signature of your health care provider is required* to verify your immunization record and tuberculosis screening on page two of the health form.

If you plan to participate in a varsity sport or club sport program; you will also need to complete the sports physical forms and get a physical examination from your health care provider before your arrival on campus.

If you choose not to get the meningococcal vaccine, you must complete, sign and return the enclosed waiver form.

Please let us know if you are unable to get the required immunizations, as we will have them available for you upon your arrival. Cost of the vaccines will be billed to your student account.

All international students and teaching assistants must report to the health center upon arrival to the campus for review of their health history and immunization records.
