* REEVES LECTURE

Professor Jeff Hammond "Look in thy Heart and Learn: Creative Writing as a Liberal Art" Owing to budgetary and other pressures, colleges and universities everywhere are increasingly being asked to justify their curricula. Courses in the arts are often the most vulnerable to this kind of scrutiny. Do such classes teach anything beyond self-expression? Do students actually "learn" something from them, and are those lessons consistent with the goals and values of a liberal arts education? In this year's Reeves Lecture, Professor Hammond reflects on the potential learning outcomes of the creative writing class, with a particular focus on creative nonfiction.
