# **Bomb Threat Call Procedures**

Most bomb threats are received by phone. Bomb threats are serious until proven otherwise. Act quickly, but remain calm and obtain information with the checklist.

### *If a bomb threat is received by phone:*

- 1. Remain calm. Keep the caller on the line for as long as possible. **DO NOT HANG UP**, even if the caller does.
- 2. Listen carefully. Be polite and show interest.
- 3. Try to keep the caller talking to learn more information.
- 4. If possible, write a note to a colleague to call the thorities or, as soon as the caller hangs up, ately notify them yourself.
- 5. If your phone has a display, copy the number and/or letters on the window display.
- 6. Complete the Bomb Threat Checklist immediately. Write down as much detail as you can remember. Try to get exact words.
- 7. Immediately upon termination of the call, do not hang up, but from a different phone contact the Office of Public Safety immediately with information and await instructions.

## If a bomb threat is received by handwritten note:

- Call the Office of Public Safety at 240-895-4911
- Handle the note as minimally as possible

# If a bomb threat is received by email:

- Call the Office of Public Safety at 240-895-4911
- Do not delete the message

#### Signs of a suspicious package:

- No return address
- Excessive postage
- Stains
- Strange odor
- Strange sounds
- Unexpected delivery
- \* Poorly handwritten
- \* Misspelled words
- \* Incorrect titles
- \* Foreign postage
- \* Restrictive notes

#### DO NOT:

- Use two-way radios or cellular phone; radio signals have the potential to detonate a bomb.
- Evacuate the building until public safety and/or police arrive and evaluate the threat.
- Activate the fire alarm.
- Touch or move a suspicious package
