Whereas: The college allows SGA clubs access to the fleet of motor vehicles and covers fuel expenses for said vehicles;

Whereas: Clubs have expressed aggravation with the difficulty of securing a state vehicle from the college;

Whereas: The college covers all maintenance costs of vehicles in the state fleet;

Whereas: The college has agreed to designate a vehicle purchased by the SGA for the exclusive use of SGA sponsored clubs;

Whereas: The state contract offers just one option for a 12 passenger van;

Whereas: Under this contract there are several available options for an additional cost:

(Base line price of van = \$18,785.00)

1. 4.10 Limited Slip Rear – add \$315.00
2. Exterior Upgrade Package – add \$395.00
3. Power Windows/Locks – add \$495.00
4. Daytime Running Lights – add \$45.00
5. Rear Step Bumper – add \$170.00
6. Running Boards – add \$320.00
7. Speed Control – add \$240.00
8. Stereo C/D – add \$275.00
9. Privacy Glass – add \$460.00
10. Diesel Engine – add \$6,367.00
11. 15 Passenger – add \$2,076.00

Be it hereby further resolved: The SGA shall allot \$38,690 to purchase two twelve passenger 2008 Ford Econoline E350 vans with additional options 4, 7, and 8;

Be it hereby further resolved: The SGA shall allot \$_____ to have the SGA logo put onto the vans;

Be it hereby further resolved: The SGA shall allot \$_____ to purchase two roof racks;

Be it hereby further resolved: SGA clubs shall be permitted to reserve these vehicles no more than 3 times each semester.
