Whereas: recycling receptacles are provided to students living on North Campus to encourage environmental stewardship.

Whereas: Many students on North Campus cook and use various food items in their houses;

Whereas: Much of the waste from food can be composted and turned into soil;

Whereas: The college has a composting site located behind DPC that is open for student use;

Whereas: The soil that is produced at this composting site is used in the garden, also located behind DPC.

Whereas: The garden provides food, herbs, and cords available to all students;

Whereas: Students are currently providing their own composting buckets;

Whereas: Providing students the opportunity to loan a composting bucket would further promote environmental stewardship as well as a sense of ownership for the garden;

Whereas: Buckets that can be used for transporting food waste can be purchased for approximately 2 dollars each;

Be it hereby resolved: The SGA approves 50 dollars be used from the special carry over fund to purchase 25 buckets to be made available to students for composting.

Be it hereby further resolved: These buckets will be numbered for identification purposes and will be signed out and in at the beginning and end of each year (respectively).
