*To the Point* - Demonstration Policy - Investigation and Action Ad Hoc Committee

Whereas: Many students have expressed serious concerns about the new demonstration clause of *To the Point*;

Whereas: This is an issue that will require a significant amount of research, time, and energy;

Whereas: A small group of students have begun to research the demonstration policy;

Whereas: Numerous SGA officers are among these students who have been working on this research;

Whereas: Creating an SGA ad-hoc committee would create a formal centralized group that students could join to learn more about, investigate, and potentially propose action on the new demonstration clause of *To the Point*;

Be it hereby ordered: The SGA will create a *To the Point* - Demonstration Policy - Investigation and Action Committee.

Be it hereby further ordered: The *To the Point* - Demonstration Policy - Investigation and Action Committee is charged with raising awareness of the addition of the demonstration clause, gathering and compiling student feedback and opinions on the policy, research of other similar policies at peer institutions, and reporting back to the SGA senate with findings;
