- II. At least 20 credit-hours in philosophy as specified in (A) and (B) below. A grade of C- or better must be received in each course used to satisfy the requirements for the minor, and the cumulative GPA in courses used to satisfy the requirements for the minor must be at least 2.0.

**A. Required Core Courses (8 credit-hours)** At least one course from each of the following:

- 2. PHIL 300 History of Ancient & Medieval Philosophy (**prereq: 1 course in philosophy**)  
**OR**  
 PHIL 301 History of Modern Philosophy (**prereq: 1 course in philosophy**)

**B. Elective Courses:**

An additional 12 credit-hours, of which at least 8 credit-hours must be upper-division, and of which at least 4 credit-hours must be non-Western philosophy.
