## Environmental Studies Major Checklist (with second major or minor in another discipline)

Beyond General College requirements, THE ENST MAJOR WITH A SECOND MAJOR OR MINOR requires a total of 10 courses and a minimum of 38 credit hours.** At least half of the credits applied towards your major must be completed at the College. In this case, a student must complete 10 courses and a minimum of 38 credit hours. The second minor or major satisfies the Depth requirement. You must still complete elective Breadth courses and must earn a grade of C - or better in all courses with a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.00 .
