FAFSA NOW OPEN

The Free Application for Student Aid (FAFSA) is now open for the 2026-2027 academic year.

Your student should fill out a FAFSA form every year they wish to receive federal and/or state aid, including scholarships, grants, and loans. (Returning students do not need to reapply for SMCM merit-based scholarships, which are automatically renewable for up to eight semesters).

Visit the <u>FAFSA website</u> to start a 2026-2027 application, or check out the <u>SMCM</u> <u>Office of Student Financial Assistance website</u> for more financial aid information. While SMCM does not have an institutional deadline for FAFSA applications, students are encouraged to complete their FAFSA as soon as possible.
