This Program Transfer Articulation Agreement (the “Agreement”) is made and entered into between Montgomery College (Sending Institution) and St. Mary’s College of Maryland (“SMCM”, Receiving Institution). This Program Transfer Articulation Agreement facilitates the transfer between the associate of fine arts in animation at Montgomery College and the bachelor of arts in studio art at St. Mary’s College of Maryland

A. Qualifying Students

This Agreement pertains to the transfer of “Qualifying Students”, *i.e.*, those students who:

1. Have successfully completed an associate of fine arts in animation at the Sending Institution;
2. Are enrolled at Montgomery College, in good standing;
3. Met the minimum grade requirements as outlined in the SMCM Catalog at <https://catalog.smcm.edu>; and
4. Completed the following coursework at Montgomery College outlined below. As part of the transfer credit evaluation process, SMCM will evaluate courses/credits earned through Advanced Placement (AP), College-Level Examination Program (CLEP), International Baccalaureate (IB) programs, military credit, or other sources of prior learning credit. SMCM policies for awarding prior learning credit will supersede prior learning credit that may have been awarded by a prior institution.
