TITLE: Academic Coaching Fellow - (Part-Time/Hourly, Contingent)

Collective Bargaining - Ineligible - Contingent Contingent positions are not eligible to participate in collective bargaining.

JOB SUMMARY:

The Academic Coaching Fellow is responsible for assisting with academic advising and coaching. This position reports to the Executive Director of Enrollment for Student Success/designee.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Responsible for following the policies and procedures as defined in the employee handbook.
- Provides one-on-one academic coaching, advising and support with students during the academic year, focusing on students on Academic Notice, those with midterm deficiencies, and students struggling academically, remotely and/or in-person.
- Provides academic pre-advising and course registration advising to newly admitted first-year and transfer students.
- Offers course registration assistance during the academic year.
- Assists with schedule changes for all students as needed.
- Conducts outreach with assigned students who receive early alerts.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Education: Bachelor's degree in education, psychology, or social work or a related field.
- Experience providing academic coaching.
- Excellent interpersonal and written communication skills.
- Ability to use the following Google applications: Sheets, Docs, Gmail.
- Comfortable making presentations (creating slides and presenting information to others).
- Appreciation for and understanding of the needs of diverse students with learning differences and the value of a liberal arts education.
- Any combination of acceptable education and experience, which has provided the necessary knowledge and skills to fulfill the requirements of this position, may be considered.
