		a. ASIA 200 Introduction to Asian Studies

		1) Complete ILCC 101 and ILCC 102: Elementary Chinese I and II

		2) Any Asian Lanugage at another college or university.
		<b>or</b>
		3) Study abroad in an Asian country including intensive language study. Programs must be approved by the Asian Studies coordinator

		4) Demonstrate at least second-semester college-level proficiency in Asian language.
