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









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

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

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


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


# Development Guidelines

# Jamie L. Roberts Stadium Site Plan



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

# Anne Arundel Hall Case Study

## Archaeology for construction: A practiced process

Step 1 - Survey the site, identify archaeology and its significance

Step 2 - Develop buildings plans that preserve/avoid archaeology to extent possible

Step 3 - Develop an archaeological mitigation plan to be **approved and permitted by the Maryland Historical Trust**

Step 4 - Complete the excavations, then begin construction
