The **Middlebury College-CMRS Oxford Humanities Program** offers a unique study abroad experience within the historic city of Oxford. The program occupies St. Michael's Hall, a 19th-century building containing lecture and seminar rooms, common rooms, a kitchen and dining area, and a library, right in the center of Oxford.

The program's long-term association with Keble College provides many opportunities for students to engage in Oxford's social and cultural life. Middlebury-CMRS students are associate members of Keble, one of Oxford's largest and friendliest colleges, which is only a short walk from St. Michael's Hall. Through Keble,

students can take meals in the magnificent dining hall, relax in the café or student common room, study in the Victorian library, join Keble clubs, and participate in a range of sports.

Middlebury-CMRS students also have access to Oxford's extensive Bodleian Library, as well as opportunities to join universitywide student associations. Throughout the semester, students can visit museums and attend local events, concerts, and theatrical performances in order to take full advantage of this culturally vibrant city.

The courses focus predominantly on the humanities and some social sciences. The program welcomes students from all academic disciplines, although an interest in the humanities is expected and encouraged. Students enroll in two individual tutorials, a group seminar, and a research course.
