Time mental health and substance abuse internship provide mental health clinicians and social workers in-depth training experience. We offer intensive weekly individual and group supervision and discussions and didactic seminars.

We offer three rotations that last four months each where our interns become part of our interdisciplinary team. Our outpatient mental health and substance abuse clinic serves children, adolescents, adults & geriatric populations for a broad range of mental health and substance abuse issues.

All our interns, staff, and patients come from diverse backgrounds and vary significantly in terms of their individual, cultural and religious identities and their presenting problems. Therefore we emphasize cultural fluency and cross-cultural diversity in our internship programs, so that cultural diversity is an integral part of our training program.
