This volume is the second supplement to A General Bibliography of The Gambia up to 31st December 1977, published by G. K. Hall of Boston in 1979, and covers the five years 1978-1982.

Seventy six per cent of the items listed are found in either original or xeroxed form in the Gamble Collection, ten per cent were seen in various libraries, and fourteen per cent come from sources such as bibliographies. Where items have not been seen they are marked with the symbol *, e.g. *67.
